



## Law Enforcement Phlebotomy Program (LEPP) Commitment Pledge

1. Complete all phases of the LEPP training.
2. Complete requalification upon expiration of each preceding LEP qualification period (every 2 years).
3. Maintain all LEPP issued equipment in good working order.
4. Complete and submit all reports required of a law enforcement phlebotomist in a timely manner (within 30 days of the date of the blood draw).
5. Be willing to respond, when needed by other agencies, in or around my county, that are requesting my services.
6. If I do not complete two requalification cycles (four years from initial qualification date), I will return all issued LEPP equipment back to the LEPP Program.
